01 Nihondaira / Nihondaira Yume Terrace

Located on a hill 307 meters above sea level, Nihondaira was once ranked first in the “Japan’s 100 Best Scenic Spots” competition. The panoramic view of Mt. Fuji rising beyond the tea fields, with Shimizu Port, the Izu Peninsula, and the Southern Alps stretching below, is truly one of Japan’s most breathtaking sights. The scenery from the Nihondaira Parkway, the access road to the summit, is so stunning that you’ll find yourself wanting to stop the car just to take it all in. In July 2016, it was officially recognized as a “Japan Night View Heritage” site by the Night View Tourism Convention Bureau.

02 Kunozan Toshogu Shrine (Accessible by ropeway from Nihondaira)

Lord Tokugawa Ieyasu overcame countless hardships from his youth and eventually rose to the rank of Great General (Sei Taishogun). In his later years, he spent his time in Sunpu (present-day Shizuoka City) and passed away on April 17, 1616, at the age of 75. Shortly before his death, Lord Ieyasu entrusted his retainers with his final wish, to have his remains buried at Mount Kuno. His successor, the second military commander (Shogun) Tokugawa Hidetada, immediately carried out this wish and ordered the construction of a shrine at Mount Kuno to enshrine Lord Ieyasu. This marked the beginning of Kunozan Toshogu Shrine.

03 Miho no Matsubara

[Registered as part of the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage “Fujisan, Sacred Place and Source of Artistic Inspiration”]

In June 2013, Miho no Matsubara was registered as one of the constituent assets of the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site “Mount Fuji, Sacred Place and Source of Artistic Inspiration.” Stretching about 5 kilometers along the coastline, this scenic area is home to roughly 30,000 pine trees. The breathtaking harmony of the green pine forest, white rolling waves, the deep blue sea, and the majestic Mount Fuji has been beautifully depicted in Utagawa Hiroshige’s ukiyo-e prints, as well as in numerous paintings and traditional Japanese poems.
